According to the government, "[t]he common chemical characteristic of PFASs is their perfluoroalkyl moiety, which is extremely stable in the environment, to the extent that PFASs have often been termed 'forever chemicals.'" The Government of Canada has announced its intention to update rules governing resource extraction projects in the Atlantic Ocean. According to the government, changes would notably: establish that the Newfoundland and Labrador and Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Boards are "the regulating bodies for offshore renewable energy projects," and update the boards' names to reflect the change; "establish a land tenure regime for the issuance of submerged land licences to carry out offshore renewable energy projects, as well as the revenues regime associated with those licences and projects;" "expand the application of the safety and environmental protection regime and its enforcement powers to include offshore renewable energy projects;" "provide that the Governor in Council may make regulations to prohibit the commencement or continuation of petroleum resource or renewable energy activities, or the issuance of interests, in respect of any portion of the offshore area that is located in an area that has been or may be identified as an area for environmental or wildlife conservation or protection;" "establish the regulatory and liability regime for abandoned facilities relating to petroleum-related works or activities or offshore renewable energy projects;" "expand the

application of the occupational health and safety regime to offshore renewable energy projects;" "allow new methods to demonstrate the existence of significant hydrocarbon accumulations in a geological feature and limit the duration of future significant discovery licences to 25 years;" and "establish a new transboundary hydrocarbon management regime to regulate fields or pools that straddle domestic and international administrative boundaries, enabling the implementation of the Canada-France transboundary fields agreement". These changes would be enacted by amending the Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act (SC1987,c3) and the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Resources Accord Implementation Act (CA-SC1988,c28).
